FISH POND



- The origins of the fishpond are believed to be medieval. Monastic communities kept fish ponds to provide fresh fish. The pond was incorporated into the garden when the house was

built in 1680. During the 1960s it was cleaned and restocked with carp.

THE WALLED GARDEN



- The walled garden has been reduced in size since it was created when Robert Cranmer took over The Canons in the 1760s. Walled gardens provided a micro-climate which was suitable

for protecting tender plants and shelter for produce grown for the mansion.
